Spread of COVID-19	<p>Participants to be aware of the current Government restrictions as any given point in time. To be displayed on club website.</p> <p>Participants and families to take personal responsibility for meeting these restrictions in their everyday life to protect themselves and their team mates/coaches</p> <p>Self-assessment to be undertaken prior to training, Players who are unwell or have been in contact with someone with suspected or confirmed COVID to stay away and advise their coaches.</p>	Minor	

<p>Football in the heart of the community</p>	<p>Whilst traveling to and from training, participants must adhere to the current guidelines on safe travel.</p> <p>Participants to arrive on time to avoid congestion at point of entry. Teams to remain separate whilst waiting entry</p> <p>Parents to bring child to gate 4, sign them in and then leave them with STJFC personnel who will admit them to the ground having used hand sanitiser.</p> <p>2m distancing to be maintained wherever possible, by all participants. Contact sessions to be kept to limited periods of time.</p> <p>Group numbers to be limited to 28 children/2 adult (with another adult watching from a safe distance) in this group shall be spread into smaller groups for activities other than training matches.</p> <p>Any shared equipment should be sanitized on regular basis.</p> <p>Parents to maintain social distancing whilst dropping/collecting children.</p>		
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<p>Football in the heart of the community</p>	<p>Parents to collect child from Gate 1 at end of session, observing social distancing whilst waiting</p> <p>Parents to prepare children for the altered environment.</p> <p>Physical contact to be avoided, (No handshakes/hi 5)</p> <p>Players will refrain from spitting/clearing nasal cavities</p> <p>All players to bring named water bottles.</p>		
<p>Children leaving site</p>	<p>Parents to drop child at Gate 4 and collect from Gate 1</p> <p>Additional adult to be on hand to assist with supervision.</p> <p>Toilet facilities will be available, but children should observe social distancing during use and wash hands after use.</p>	<p>Minor</p>	
<p>Other pitch users</p>	<p>Players to be aware of surroundings.</p> <p>Coaches to monitor vicinity for over crowding</p>	<p>Minor</p>	
<p>Injury</p>	<p>First aid bag to be available at all times.</p>	<p>Minor</p>	

Football in the heart of the community	First Aider to wear PPE whilst administering if the child cannot manage unassisted.		
Contact in play	<p>Social distancing to be observed between contact sessions Any contact sessions to be kept to less than 10 minutes Hand sanitizer to be used at beginning and end of each session by all involved.</p> <p>Any shared equipment (i.e balls goal post) should be sanitized at regular intervals.</p>	Minor	
Test and Trace	Registers are maintained of children attending, but adults are asked to check in using the QR code displayed at the gate	Minor
